Vaccinations Update

It is that time of year again! This year Quayside are offering Flu and COVID vaccinations to those patients that are eligible. You can have the flu vaccine at the same time as other vaccines such as the COVID-19, we can also book you a separate appointment for your shingles vaccine if eligible. Our vaccination clinics that we are offering will be on Saturdays throughout October, please do pop in or call us to book your appointment.

Please attend the practice for these vaccinations rather than anywhere else as your records can be immediately updated and we have already purchased your vaccine so don't want it to go to waste.

Summer Patient Data 2025

We handled a total of 19,416 calls over the three month Summer period. We booked a total of 11,889 appointments over the same period of time, of which, a total of 11,426 patients arrived for these appointments, this is a 96% attendance.

NHS Pharmacy First - Helping your GP

Your local pharmacist offers a service called Pharmacy First. You can self-refer or Quayside can direct you to a local chemist and the pharmacist can give advice and now, if necessary, prescribe medication. The following conditions that can be assessed and treated by a pharmacist are:

- 1) Impetigo (aged 1 year and over)
- 2) Infected insect bites (aged 1 year and over)
- 3) Earache (aged 1 to 17 years)
- 4) Sore throat (aged 5 years and over)
- 5) Sinusitis (aged 12 years and over)
- 6) Urinary tract infections (UTI) (women aged 16 to 64 years)
- 7) Shingles (aged 18 years and over)
